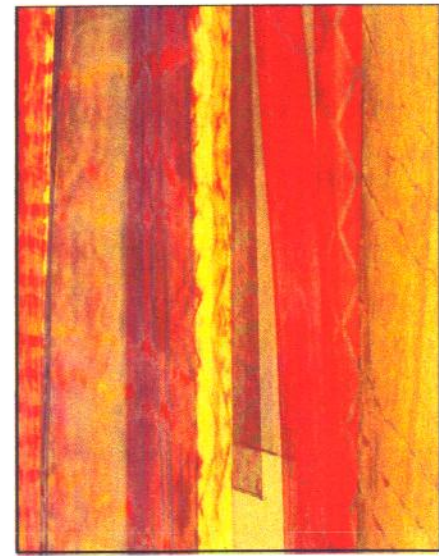
The Will Flores Fund attempts to give 90% of its funds annually to community groups providing resources to underserved constituencies.

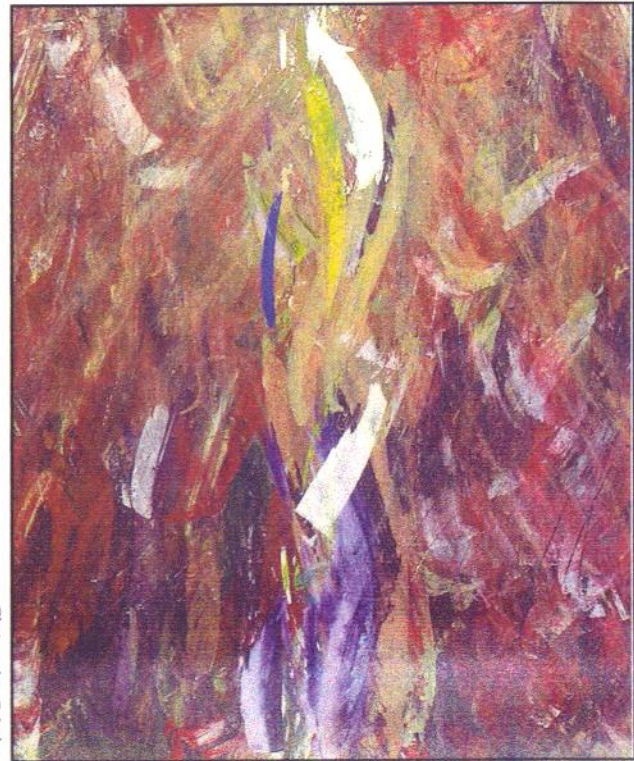

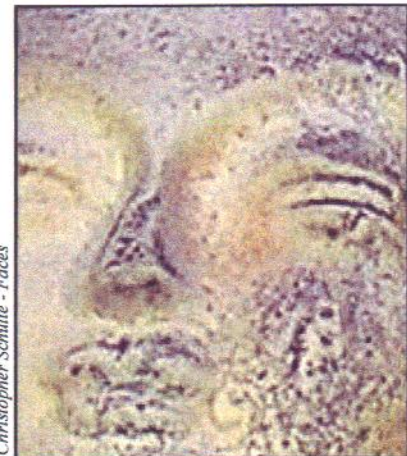
